National Innovation and Start-Up Policy Institute Level Policy

Vision

Nurturing conducive environment for innovation and start-up for students and faculty members of the institute & encourage them to consider Entrepreneurship as a career option resulting in establishment of ethical business ventures which are financially successful.

Policy

- 1. The institute shall establish incubation and accelerator facilities to foster innovation
- 2. The institute shall provide training in the field of business skill development, technology enabled efficiencies and IPR
- 3. Students & faculty shall be allowed to use the Institute address for registration of their business venture and shall be allowed to work from the institute
- 4. Students and faculty members shall be eligible for certain concessions such as attendance etc. if they are involved in incubation of entrepreneurial activity with a prior permission from the competent authority.
- 5. The institute will facilitate the start-up activities/ technology development by allowing students/ faculty/ staff to use institute infrastructure and facilities.
- 6. In return of the services and facilities, institute may take 2% to 9.5% equity/ stake in the start-up/ company, based on brand used, faculty contribution, support provided and use of institute's IPR as decided on case to case basis.
- 7. The institute shall extend this start-up facility to alumni of the institute as well as outsiders based on prior permission from the competent authority.
- 8. The institute shall encourage faculty members to participate in start-up related activities and the same shall be considered while evaluating the annual performance of the faculty.
- 9. The institute encourage every faculty to be a mentor to at least one start-up.
- 10. In case of institute facilities / funds are used or when IPR is developed as a part of curriculum/ academic activity, IPR is to be jointly owned by inventors and the institute.
- 11. Interdisciplinary research and publication on start-up and entrepreneurship shall be promoted by the institute.
- 12. The institute shall develop policy and guidelines for forming and managing the relationships with external stakeholders including private industries.
- 13. The institute shall facilitate Entrepreneurship education to students at curricular/ cocurricular/ extracurricular level through elective/ short term or long-term courses on innovation, entrepreneurship and venture development.
- 14. The institute shall collaborate with other stakeholders such as Industry, industry associations, business clusters and other eminent institutes for knowledge exchange and support.
- The institute shall conduct impact assessment of its entrepreneurial activities annually based on defined evaluation parameters.
