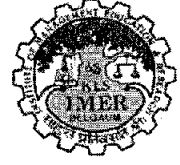

Objective:

The main objective of the meeting was to create awareness among girl students about the legal implications, institutional policies, and psychological impact of ragging and to ensure a safe and inclusive hostel environment.

Summary of the Event:

An Anti-Ragging Awareness Meeting was conducted for the girl students staying in the hostel of KLS IMER. The session began with an address by the Faculty Coordinator, who emphasized the strict anti-ragging policies enforced by the institute in line with UGC regulations. The students were briefed about the Anti-Ragging Committee and the available support mechanisms including helpline numbers and grievance redressal procedures.

The students were also informed about the disciplinary actions that follow if any ragging incident is reported. Interactive discussions took place to clarify students' doubts and encourage peer vigilance to maintain a ragging-free atmosphere.

Outcome:

Increased awareness about the consequences of ragging.

Students were sensitized on the importance of mutual respect and maintaining a positive hostel environment.

Reaffirmation of zero tolerance towards ragging in any form.
