

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for Students and Faculty Exchange

between

Chhatrapati Shahu Institute of Business Education and Research (CSIBER), Kolhapur, 416004, Maharashtra State, India

And

Karnatak Law Society's Institute of Management Education and Research (KLS IMER) Autonomous, Belagavi, Karnataka

With a view to strengthen academic relations, Karnatak Law Society's Institute of Management Education and Research (KLS IMER), Belagavi and Chhatrapati Shahu Institute of Business Education and Research (CSIBER-India), Kolhapur, have agreed to facilitate an academic exchange. The prime goal of this MoU is to foster collaborations, provide opportunity to faculty and students for sharing learning experience/s and best practice/s, thereby enable the advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity.

1. Objectives:

- a) to create appropriate communication interface that can support enhanced information sharing, identification of thematic areas of common interest and lay the foundation for enhanced collaborations (Information exchange)
- to jointly organize short-term continuing education programme/s on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein (Faculty exchange)
- to jointly organize seminars, conferences or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- e) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at post graduate level for limited periods of time for the purpose of educational programme/s and /or research.
- f) To exchanges cultural perspectives of students and faculty members.
- g) To explore possibilities and offer MDP's for the industry or corporate/s. KLS IMER and CSIBER-India further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, and person/s responsible for its implementation and so on.

2. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

CSIBER-India and KLS IMER agree to encourage collaboration between the two institutions. Specifically, to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in Research and Development Programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between KLS IMER and CSIBER-India.

3. Students and Faculty Exchange

KLS IMER and CSIBER agree that student exchange will be guided by the principles listed below.





- A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and
 from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that
 receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme
 of study or research.
- Exchange students will be selected by the home institution.
- An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- To avail of travel expenses, faculty and students can apply for existing funding programs/financial arrangements at their respective home institutions.
- To provide a decent stay and food facility for the faculty and student would be the responsibility of the host institution.
- · Both institutions will encourage the exchange of students for:
 - Study programs in disciplines offered by both institutions and/or
 - > Internship opportunities

4. Intellectual Property

The intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case- by- case basis and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

5. Co- ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to co-ordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a co-ordination committee, consisting of(a) Director, CSIBER - India, or his/her nominee, (b)Director, KLS-IMER, or his/her nominee, and (c) Programme co-ordinator from the side of CSIBER - India, and (d) Programme Co-ordinator from the side of KLS-IMER, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

6. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for three years and may be continued thereafter, after a suitable review and agreement through a new MoU document. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither CSIBER - India nor KLS-IMER will be responsible





for any losses, financial or otherwise, that the other institutions may suffer. However, CSIBER - India and KLS-IMER will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

7. Arbitration Clause

Any disputes arising in connection with this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual discussion between the Director, KLS IMER and CSIBER - India.with a spirit of independence, mutual respect and a sense of shared responsibility.

8. Amendments

Any modifications or revisions to this MoU shall be made in writing and duly executed by authorized representatives of both the institutions.
